Resolution to Eliminate Conflicts of Interest (Resolution #6)

General: To eliminate potential conflicts of interest, members of the National AFAA Board of Directors shall not serve as board or executive board members for any affiliate associations. Information shared with the AFAA National BOD is confidential and membership on an affiliate association creates a potential conflict of interest when policies and procedures of the affiliate associations is discussed.

***Section 5 – Attendance at Board Meetings**

The attendance of Officers and Directors at all meetings is necessary for the welfare of the organization. If for any reason it becomes necessary for an Officer or Director to miss two (2) regular meetings or three (3) meetings in total (both regular and special) during a fiscal year, he or she may be removed for cause.
